THE TOWN OF CORINTH PLANNING BOARD HELD A WORKSHOP MEETING TO DISCUSS AND DELIVER A RECOMMENDATION TO THE TOWN BOARD REGARDING THE LOCAL LAW AMENDING THE CORINTH TOWN CODE RELATING TO DISPOSAL OF WASTE.

Chairperson Reed said that the Planning Boards next scheduled meeting on April 19 would be held at 6:00 pm and **not** 7:00pm.

Attorney Pozefsky said that he would like to read through the Law Amending the Corinth Town Code Relating to Disposal of Waste. Attorney Pozefsky told the Planning Board that there had been changes made to the law as of today. Attorney Pozefsky said that the Town Board was working on a separate composting law, that the moratorium is still in effect, and that the law that the Planning Board is reviewing tonight is not going to effect the new composting law. Attorney Pozefsky said that the Article 1 in the Local Law Amending the Corinth Town Code relating to Waste Disposal basically tells why the changes are being made. Attorney Pozefsky covered the Articles and Sections of this proposed law and briefly explained each section and items that have changed. Attorney Pozefsky said that Article 4 of this law is not intended to affect the moratorium on composting.

After addressing the Articles and sections of the Local Law the Town

#### of Corinth Planning Board had the following recommendations:

- 1.) In section 71-4 the Planning Board recommends defining "natural organic materials".
- 2.) In section87-1 the Planning Board recommends that trailers of every kind, whether powered or not, be included in the junkyard law.
