Dear Property Owner:

I am writing this letter to inform you that Saratoga County Department of Public Works will be reconstructing County Road No. 24, Palmer Ave. from County Road No. 25 to the Corinth Village line, a total distance of 2.90 miles. We will make every effort to reduce the impact of this project on our residents. However, there may be some inconveniences related to the construction that will be unavoidable.

For your information, our standard roadway will consist of two (2) 10 ft. lanes with paved shoulders. The alignment of the highway will remain approximately the same. However, to properly reconstruct the highway, the drainage system must be rebuilt. This will entail clearing of trees within the County Right-of-Way and ditching alongside the highway. Tree removal may also be required to eliminate roadside hazards. Any trees needing removal will be marked in advance in case there is a question about the "right-of-way" line.

In advance of our work, we also ask that if you know the location of your property corners that you either flag them, if possible, or to provide this office with a copy of a map indicating the location of the property corners so that we may do so.

This project will result in a much safer and more easily maintained roadway for our residents. We thank you for your understanding and cooperation. If you have any questions, you may contact Bill Benosky at 885-2235
