After Roll Call and Pledge of Allegiance the following business was conducted:

ASSESSOR

Assessor Mary Ellen Hill-Pierce presented the Town Board with an up date of the 2008 Assessment that is well under way.

COMPREHENSIVE COMMITTEE UPDATE

Supervisor Lucia told the board that within the next two weeks the first meeting of the Comprehensive Committee, Jim Marton from LA Group, the Town attorneys and the Saratoga county Planning Board will be held.

LOCAL LAW UPDATE

Supervisor Lucia told the public that the amended Local Law regarding Waste Disposal has been sent to the Town of Corinth Planning Board for their review. He told the board that the Planning Board sent the revised Local Law to Attorney Pozefsky for his review and comments before they made any recommendations to the Town Board. He said after the Town Board receives recommendations from the Town Planning Board the Revised Local Law must go to the Saratoga County Planning Board for their review and recommendations and then a Public Hearing can be scheduled.

JULY 4th CLOSURE

Supervisor Lucia told the public that the Town Hall will be closed on Wednesday, July 4th, and in the afternoon of Friday, July 6th, in observance of the Fourth of July.

Highway Superintendent Harry Plummer showed the Board pictures of the new building his department constructed at the Landfill for the attendants.

CODE ENFORCEMENT OFFICER

Code Enforcement Officer Mann asked Supervisor Lucia if the Town Attorneys had contacted him with any answers or comments regarding the Scott Eagle property. Supervisor Lucia told him that the Town Attorneys are still looking into the matter and will let the board know as soon as they can about how the attorneys feel the Town should proceed.

TOWN BOARD

Councilman Brown told the board that there was a emergency drill on the Sacandaga Dam at the Corinth Fire House on June 27th and the emergency Management Committee will be working along the lines of the results of this drill. Councilman Brown said that the we were unsuccessful in obtaining a grant for the Siren Alert System but he now knows of different areas to contact for possible money to cover the Siren Alert System and he will be looking into this.

Supervisor Lucia told the board that on June 27th the annual Corinth Fun Day was held at the Corinth School. He said it was very well attended and everyone seemed to have a great time. He told the board that Wes Carr from Saratoga County Youth Bureau and the Youth Commission are responsible for arranging for this event every year.

Councilman Major told Highway Superintendent Plummer that he was asked by several citizens in the South Corinth area to express their gratitude to Highway Superintendent Plummer and his crew for the job they did in South Corinth regarding the dam, etc.
