

APRIL 17, 2008

The Town Board of the Town Of Corinth held a workshop on April 17, 2008 at 4:00PM at the Town Hall.

After roll call the following business was conducted:

Highway Superintendent Eggleston discussed his department 5year projection plan. He anticipates .92 miles of Antone Mountain Rd., .25 miles of Harris Rd., and .37 miles of Eggleston Street will be paved this year and possibly .50 miles of West Mountain Rd, depending on funds. The garage needs some updates and we may need to purchase a wood chipper to dispose of brush at landfill. D.E.C. has said that open burning permits may not be issued after 2008-2009. This law is not definite but we may want to find alternate ways to dispose of brush.

Superintendent Eggleston also said there is a large pile of old tires that need to be disposed of.

Superintendent Eggleston is waiting for a permit from D.E.C. to remove the beaver dam that is causing flooding in the area of Eggleston Street and Dorset Drive. When the beaver dam is removed the water should then flow through the drainpipe into the ditch and down to the creek.

Supervisor Lucia explained the new bookkeeping system and banking plan.

There was a lengthy discussion between the Board, Jim Hamm and Michelle Wyman regarding the use variance he wants so that he can remove Michelle's mobile to his property on Hamm Road. The Board suggested that Michelle contact the neighbors around Hamm Road to get their input on changing the zoning to allow the mobile to be moved there. Jim Hamm was also told he would have to get a letter from the zoning board saying they rejected his application for a variance. At that point the board would consider the application.

Supervisor Lucia said there would be a meeting with Richard Butler, Architect from Butler Rowland Mays and all departments in the building at 10:00 am on Friday to talk about renovating the town hall.

Supervisor Lucia asked the board to go over the resolution authorizing solicitation of bids for removal of mobile homes from property at 165 Howe Road. Will go over the resolution at the meeting on Thursday April 24th, 2008.

Supervisor Lucia said Morgan Estates must have the Army Engineers send us a letter saying the request for information has been satisfied and they are proceeding with the application for a permit. Until then no permits or CO's will be issued by the Building Department.

Councilman Byrnes reported that the Merchants association is in the process of getting a new locator map together. This map is beneficial to the Town and the area. The association charges for ads, but the locator is expensive to publish and they are around \$1000.00 short of funds and figure they would have to cut out some of the information that is usually put in it. They are delaying the publication until July. They were wondering if the town and the village could possibly help subsidize the project? The Board thought that it would be a good idea and the village board should also be approached. Councilman Byrnes will get back to them with a figure.

A platform for the railroad was discussed and Councilman Saunders said he would like to see some kind of cover over it.

With no further business, on a motion by Councilman Byrnes and seconded by Councilman Major the meeting was adjourned at 6:30 PM. Carried unanimously.
