Marvin & Company

Marvin Olick and Michelle DeGarmo of Marvin & Company appeared before the board and explained where they are regarding our CDBG. Supervisor Lucia told them that the Town Committee for the grant would consist of Supervisor Lucia, Councilman Saunders, Town Clerk Farr, Code Enforcement Officer Mann and Supervisor's Secretary Lisa Rumpf. Michelle gave the Town Board a copy of a new application. She said that they reviewed all the applications that have already been filed in the Town and they suggest that a letter be sent for them to update the income on each application. She said that their firm has condensed the application. She told the board that they have over 26 applications from 2005 or before and approximately 10 applications prior to 2005.

Councilman Saunders asked if we limited the amount that we allowed per household. Code Enforcement Officer said that it was done by income and then by need. Councilman Saunders said we did not know the names and Martin said that the committee would go by number only. Councilman Saunders asked about the problems that the Town had with contactors. Code Enforcement Officer Mann said that he would work with Marvin to check out the contractors. Marvin explained what was necessary for all contractors interested in being on the list.

Councilman Byrnes asked if there would be applications at the Town Hall. Michelle said that the Town already has enough applications on file. Town Clerk Farr asked if we could still take applications. Marvin said that it would be to the Town's benefit for the next grant application to show that the Town is still in great need for more grant money.

Supervisor Lucia asked how soon the letter and new applications would be sent out. Michelle said that it could go out as early as Monday if the letter was approved by the Supervisor.

Supervisor Lucia said that he feels very fortunate that the Town of Corinth received this grant. He said only two grants were awarded in Saratoga County and only on housing grant that Town of Corinth received.

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Councilman Major asked about other grants that are out there for Highway grants for roads, etc. Marvin and Michelle said that they would check and get back to him if they found any.
