Supervisor

Supervisor Lucia gave the Town Board a copy of the Landfill Yearly Profit and Loss Statement.

Supervisor Lucia told the Town Board that the Planning Board was not going to have a meeting tonight but since receiving the letter from the Town Clerk with Proposed Local Law 1-2011 they have rescheduled their meeting.
