Joel Jenkins asked the board about the soda machine at the EMS building. Supervisor Lucia told him that it was not arranged through the Town so he would have to contact whoever it was arranged through. Mr. Jenkins asked since the soda is now \$1.75 if he could purchase the soda through the Town and just sell it for less. Supervisor Lucia said he thought that up front purchase could be made through the budget line item for the squad.

Joel Jenkins asked about volunteers. He said that on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday nights they are short and paramedics are filing in. Supervisor Lucia told him that there are two people on a probationary basis right now. Councilman Byrnes suggested that the Town place another ad in the Pennysaver for more volunteers.

Jim Murray said he understood that there are two paramedics on Thursday night so that they can keep one paramedic in the community all the time since it is so busy.

Jim Murray, Sr. spoke to the board about the need for advertising what is available in Corinth. Councilman Byrnes told him that there is advertising on the Merchants Board in the center of the Village and at area campgrounds, etc. He said the problem is there are not enough volunteers to do extensive advertising. Councilman Byrnes told Mr. Murray if he knew of any volunteers to contact him and he would see what could be done.

Supervisor Lucia said that he had spoken with Chris Papa and he has his father's old deeds in his possession. Supervisor Lucia said he thought they might help with finding the exact boundary lines. Councilman Byrnes said that the County suggested getting in contact with the Town engineer for help. Supervisor Lucia said that he would contact the Town's engineer and see what they could do.

Councilman Byrnes told the board that the road into the Depot needs to have something done to it if the Town and Village were going to promote the train. Supervisor Lucia said that Highway Superintendent Eggleston and Arthur Lozier, III of the Village would be the ones to contact about that. Councilman Byrnes said that he now has the time that he could work on this matter.
