**Insurance Presentation**

Cassandra Martin from USI gave a presentation on health insurance for the Town for 2013. Mrs. Martin discussed several options for the Town:

- Renewal of current policy - overall increase of 3.9%;
- CDPHP Option 1 - overall increase of 2.8%;
- CDPHP Option 2 - overall increase of 0.0%
- Option 1 HDHP/CDPHP - -19%
- Option 2 HDHP/CDPHP - -28%
- Option 3 HDHP/CDPHP- -35%

- Option 4 HDHP/CDPHP - -65%
- Option 5 HDHP/CDPHP - -66%

Mrs. Martin discussed Health Reimbursement Arrangement (HRA) with the board at length.

Mrs. Martin also told the board that the renewal of the Dental Plan for the Town is going up 7% and the Vision Plan for the Town is going up 4%, She suggests that the Town renew both these plans.

Mrs. Martin said that whatever the board decided she would come back and speak to the employees if needed.

Supervisor Lucia told the Town Board that two different architects have looked at the Town Hall roof. He said that architects from Saratoga Associates will be drawing up the architect plan for the roof and as soon as the Town has them they can put the roof out to bid.

Code Enforcement Officer Hickok told the board that Mr. Paquin is coming in to compliance with the demolition permit. There is already a doublewide on the property and Code Enforcement Officer Hickok said he wanted to have Mr. Paquin

remove the present doublewide and clean up the property before bringing in the other doublewide. Code Enforcement Officer Hickok told the board that there are two separate lots and two separate wells so this can be done. Code Enforcement Hickok said that he thinks the clean up should be done by spring and everything should be in an agreement drawn up by the town attorney.

Robert Eggleston asked the Town Board if people who are soliciting in the Town needed to obtain a permit. The board told Mr. Eggleston that there is nothing in the Code that requires a permit.
