After roll call and Pledge of Allegiance the following business was conducted:

Supervisor Lucia told the board that the report from the County for mortgage tax collected for December 2012 shows \$9,180.35.

Town Clerk Farr told the board that she had a gentlemen come in who requested a dog license for a service dog. The type of service dog the man was talking about was not listed and the Town Attorney said that the matters would have to be treated on a case to case basis. Town Clerk Farr said that Cameron Smith paid for the license and is at the meeting tonight to explain about his step father's service dog and see if the board agrees that this is a service dog and should be exempt from fee. Cameron Smith told the board that the dog has been trained to sense when his step-father is having a problem breathing and alert his mother who is hearing impaired.
