Dear Supervisor Lucia:


Please be advised that the Village of Corinth is planning to undertake a project which will rehabilitate the existing water storage tank. Rehabilitation will require that the water storage tank be completely drained and out of service beginning on September 30, 2013 for approximately 30-45 days. The Village will be notifying all users to conserve water during this time to avoid unnecessary usage and preserve water supply capacity.

While the tank is off-line, water supply and pressures will be maintained by manual "hand" switching of the two supply pumps with at least one pump in continuous operation at all times. In the event of a fire or other emergency water demands may require simultaneous operation of both pumps. The Village does not expect that water demands will exceed the output of two pumps running simultaneously.

**The Village will be prepared to activate both pumps upon notice of an emergency. In the event of an emergency during this period that demands high volumes of water, please call DPW Superintendent Arthur Lozier, III at (518) 654-2373.**
