PROPOSED LOCAL LAW NO. 3 OF 2014 RELATING TO
ON-SITE SEPTIC / WASTEWATER TREATMENT SYSTEMS
IN THE TOWN OF CORINTH**

RESOLUTION NO.:220

WHEREAS, the New York State Department of Health (NYSDOH) requires the involvement of a licensed design professional for the design, planning and installation of residential on-site septic / wastewater treatment systems for new residential

construction, additions and alterations and, in some cases, repair and replacement of these systems; and

WHEREAS, the Town's Code includes provisions for compliance with NYSDOH requirements for new construction, additions and alterations but does not address repair and replacement of on-site septic / wastewater treatment systems not associated with other construction; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board wishes to clarify and highlight this NYSDOH requirement and has prepared an appropriate Local Law; and

WHEREAS, New York Municipal Home Rule Law requires a Public Hearing to be held prior to adoption of a Local Law; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to 6 New York Code of Rules and Regulations ("NYCRR") Section 617.6, the Town Board is the lead agency under the State Environmental Quality Review Act ("SEQRA") for adoption of Local Law No. ___;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED, that the Board determines that adoption of Local Law No. 3 is an Unlisted Action under SEQRA and authorizes preparation of Part 1 of the SEQRA Short Environmental Assessment Form ("EAF"); and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Corinth Town Board shall hold a Public Hearing on Thursday, November 13, 2014, beginning at 7:05 p.m. at the Corinth Town Hall, 600 Palmer Avenue, Corinth, New York, concerning proposed Local Law No.3 of 2014 to hear all interested persons, and at that time may take any other actions authorized by law concerning proposed Local Law No.:3 of 2014; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Town Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to publish and post legal notice of the Public Hearing on proposed Local Law No. 3 of 2014 in the manner provided by law, and shall make a copy of the proposed Local Law available for public inspection in the Town Clerk's office following the adoption of this Resolution and until the Public Hearing is closed.
