WHEREAS, The Town of Corinth joins to support observances that raise awareness of health issues that affect people across our state, nation, and the world, such as the various types of cancer, including brain cancer; and

WHEREAS, brain tumors, both primary (originating in brain tissue) and secondary (originating in other parts of the body that metastasize to the brain) are diagnosed in more than 210,000 Americans of all ages, races, socio-economic status and gender each year and continue to rise annually; and


WHEREAS, over 1,100 Americans will be diagnosed with a brain tumor in 2016, and
