Attorney Hafner reported to the Town Board that he had received information at another Town Board meeting regarding inspection of septic tanks and that it could be done by an engineer or an architect. Councilman Byrnes reported that the Code Enforcement office had compiled a suggestion list for residents on people to call for assistance.

Highway Superintendent Eggleston

Highway Superintendent Eggleston reported that Angel Road was finished and that he was preparing Fuller Road to be started on Monday.

Supervisor Lucia informed the Town Board that a FOIL request was received in the Town Clerks office regarding a neighbor dispute at the corner of Hack Road and County Rte. 25 and that copies were placed in their mailboxes. Supervisor Lucia reported that the request was forwarded to Town Council for review.

Supervisor Lucia stated that he was told Code Enforcement Brooks was receiving complaint calls from seasonal campers at Alpine Lake RV Resort on Heath Road for fire hazards due to electrical issues. Supervisor Lucia explained to the Town Board that Code Enforcement does not do electrical inspections and after several calls with the property owners/managers he was informed that Gross Electric is in there servicing the campground.

Supervisor Lucia reminded the Town Board that budgets are due Monday and that he had made several phone calls regarding the rates since he was receiving conflicting figures from neighboring towns. Supervisor Lucia stated that the county control was at .2%.
