The Town Board of the Town of Corinth held a workshop on March 30, 2017 at 4:30PM at the Town Hall.

After the pledge of allegiance and roll call the following business was conducted:

Supervisor Lucia presented the Town Board with the fireman's invitation to Old Timers' Night asking each board member to respond.

Supervisor Lucia asked the Town Board if there were any concerns regarding the Fire Contract that was discussed at the joint village/town meeting last week. Town Clerk Rose Farr presented the Town Board with meeting minutes from 2009 & 2010 regarding fire contract talks. Ms. Farr also presented, as requested, fire contracts for 2008, 2009 and 2010 for the councilmen's review. Discussions were made regarding the Town's 64% accountability for the fire budget and how this decision was made. Councilman Collura stated that if the Town of Corinth has a 2/3 of the budget responsibilities then shouldn't the Town of Corinth hold the ability to make decisions and have a voice in votes. Councilman Halliday stated that it would seem the budget is based on assessment, as stated in a meeting minute record from 2008 with former Councilman Saunders suggesting this. Supervisor Lucia stated he has requested documentation from the Village of Corinth on the agreement to pay 64% of the fire contract.

Supervisor Lucia presented the Town Board with a rewording of Steve Smead's resolution to remain on the Board of Assessment review adding that this was the result of Mr. Smead moving out of the town and Saratoga County and that this was an individual case not to set precedent for future members.
