Supervisor Lucia told the board that Senator Tedisco also told him that the Town of Corinth could apply for a \$100,000.00 grant for certain items, a list of which the Supervisor has. He asked that if any of the councilmen knew of something that was needed they let him know so that the grant application could get sent in as soon as possible.

Supervisor Lucia gave the board a copy of the Assessor's report from January through April 2017.

Supervisor Lucia gave the board members a copy of a letter from JDRF (Juvenile Diabetes Research Foundation) regarding a JDRF Ride for Cure to be held September 16, 2017. There also was a map showing where the tour will be going through Corinth.

Supervisor Lucia told the board that budget worksheets will be going out to the Department Heads on August 1<sup>st</sup> and must be returned by August 15<sup>th</sup>.

Supervisor Lucia told the board that the Sales Tax for June was \$97,512.00.
