Town Attorney

Town Attorney Everhart stated the following:

- Town Attorney Leah Everhart said that have been working on the proposed local law to exceed the tax cap. And a public hearing needs to be scheduled.

Councilman Butler-

- Requested that the board receive an activity log from the justices along with the monthly report.

Councilman Collura

Councilman Collura spoke about the following:

- Stated the Town did not have a building inspector here this week and hoped that it did not have a negative impact on the builders in Town. Supervisor Lucia said that there wasn't any; that the Building inspector spoke with everyone before he left. Town Clerk Farr said there was one emergency but that the new Village Inspector helped with resolving the issue.
- A member of the public requested that the Town continue to help the seniors get to their medical appointments. Supervisor Lucia said the town still does but they can't do it like the last one, which was so costly. Supervisor Lucia said the County has programs available for those situations. Supervisor Lucia said if a senior is in need they should contact Laurie Crossman at the Senior Center and if she can't help them, then they should contact him.
- Wanted to know if someone at the Village could address the lighting situation at the football field. Councilman Collura said this is potentially a dangerous situation with children crossing the street at night after the football games because this area is so poorly lit.

Highway Superintendent

Highway Superintendent Eggleston spoke about the following:

- That 4 new signs have been put up entering the Town. They repaired one and another is beyond repair.

Town Clerk Farr

- Asked if budget meetings had been scheduled yet. Supervisor Lucia said he thought there was going to be a workshop with the board members next Wednesday but it wasn't confirmed yet.

Deputy Town Clerk Sullivan

Deputy Sullivan spoke about the following:
