- Chipping Brush-

Supervisor Lucia said Councilman Byrnes was investigating other options & the person he contacted is no longer in business. Supervisor Lucia said Mr. Eggleston would like to move forward with the bid that was placed by Rick Sears and needed a motion.

RESOLVED that Rick Sears be hired at the cost of \$10,000.00 to do the chipping of brush at the landfill.

- Paving of Surrey Road for extension fill -in-

Supervisor Lucia said that Shawn is on Surry Road, Barbara Mac Donald Drive and outer Main Street milling, and has been parking all of his equipment over on Ralph Petruzzo’s Road. Ralph is ready for Shawn to approve the road in his development the goes from Barbara Mac Donald to Surrey Road and he asked if Shawn could pave it and he would pay for the paving and the labor. Highway Superintendent Eggleston said he could do it with Board approval.

Town Clerk Farr asked if he was sure that Petruzzo still owned that property because she thought it was owned by Greens @Corinth LTD.

Councilman Collura asked if he was going to put any money down. Supervisor Lucia said he did not know, but that the specifics were being worked out between Ralph and Shawn. Supervisor Lucia said Mr. Petruzzo did say he was willing to pay for materials and labor. Councilman Collura said he would vote to approve if it was reviewed by the Town Attorney. Councilman Collura suggested having something in

writing stating that the Town will be reimbursed. Supervisor Lucia said he would run it past the Town Attorney. Supervisor Lucia said Ralph was looking to start building the houses back there in the fall.

Highway Superintendent Eggleston said they should be using the dumpsters at Alpine. Town Clerk Farr told the couple that the recycling center is free, and it is run by the county and she would get back to them about the dump sticker. Town Clerk Farr said that we don't allow others have a dump sticker because they don't pay taxes in the Town. It was decided that Dump stickers are for Town taxpayers because the landfill money comes out of tax money. Supervisor Lucia said that if they have an alpine sticker, they are charged non-resident fees. Town Clerk Farr said that she explained to them that they can still use the landfill, but they will be charged a higher rate. Supervisor Lucia said that they are all set with this then.
