**RESOLUTION # 280
ADOPTS PROVISIONS OF EXECUTIVE ORDER 202.83 SUSPENDING THE
REQUIREMENTS OF RENEWAL APPLICATIONS AS A CONDITION TO GRANTING
EXECPTIONS UNDER SECTIONS 459-C AND 467 OF**

THE REAL PROPERTY TAX LAW.

Councilman Halliday offered the following resolution

Which was seconded by Councilman Collura

WHEREAS, the Governor of the State of New York by Executive Order No. 202 dated March 7, 2020, declared a state disaster emergency for the entire State of New York; and

WHEREAS, both travel-related and community contact transmission of COVID-19 have been documented in New York State and are expected to continue; and

WHEREAS, PURSUANT TO Section 29-a of Article 2-b of the Executive Order 202.83, which temporarily suspends or modifies, subdivision 7, 7-a and 8 of section 459-c of the Real Property Tax Law and subdivisions 5, 5-a and 6 of section 467 of the Real Property Tax Law.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that pursuant to executive Order 202.83 issued by New York State Governor Andrew Cuomo on December 18, 2020, the Town Board of the Town of Corinth hereby adopts, as a local option the suspension of subdivisions 7, 7-a and 8 of section 459-c of the Real Property Tax Law and Subdivisions 5, 5-a, 5-b, 5-c and 6 of section 467 of the Real Property Tax Law; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Town of Corinth Assessor is hereby directed to grant exemptions pursuant to such sections on the 2021-2022 assessment roll to all property owners who received that exception on the 2020-2021 assessment roll, thereby dispensing with the need for renewal applications from such persons, and further dispensing with the requirement of the Town of Corinth Assessor to mail renewal applications to such person; and, be it further

RESOLVED, that the Town Clerk is hereby directed to forward a copy of this resolution to the Town of Corinth Assessor and the Office of the Town of Corinth Attorney; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Town of Corinth Departments may review and obtain an election copy of this resolution and if needed, a certified copy of same may be obtained from the Office of the Town Clerk.
