Covid-19 Update:

County warns public about small gatherings. SCPHS continues to see positive COVID-19 cases arising from small gatherings held between family and friends that live in different households. While it's natural to let your guard down when in the presence of family and friends, you may not be aware of the activities of those outside your household, putting you and your immediate family at a greater risk of contracting COVID-19.

The NY State Department of Health defines close contact as someone who was within 5 feet of an infected person for more than 10 minutes or over a 24 hour period starting from 2 days before the illness onset, or for asymptomatic patients, two days prior to test specimen collection.

As a practical consideration, SCPHS will be quarantining those persons who were within 6 feet of the positive case regardless of mask wearing. If SCPHS cannot make an absolute determination that all individuals within a family and friend group were not within 6 feet of a positive case, all individuals in the group will be quarantined. This is in line with the "abundance of caution" doctrine practiced by SCPHS.
