Medical Insurance Presentation/Debbie Dudley & Augie Cassela:

Augie Cassela will be handling the Town of Corinth account. He discussed all 4 plans for employees and retirees. Dental, Vision, and medicare plan post 65. CDPHP is the only increase. It would go up 4%, \$11,483.00 for the year. 3 slight changes to the plan regarding co-pays.

Mr. Cassela also discussed the option of the MVP plan that is comparable but the fees to employees for various services would increase.

Councilman Collura asked questions regarding each of the plans to clarify some of the information.

Supervisor Lucia mentioned that Cherie has not had any complaints about the current plan.
