The COVID update for today is below.

- Total cases of COVID-19: 13,338
- New cases since last update (3/30/21): 51
- Deaths: 155
- Recovered cases: 12,851
- Active cases: 383
- Hospitalizations: 18
- 7-day rolling average positivity rate: 3.1%
- Total tested: 404,319

As of 3/30/21, 81,724 Saratoga County residents have received at least one dose of COVID vaccine. 49,475 Saratoga County residents have completed the vaccine series.
