- **Arrives in Corinth at 8:32 a.m., Saratoga at 9:16 a.m. back in Corinth going North at 10:44 a.m. back in Corinth @ 5:17 p.m. Goes back to Saratoga and back in Corinth @7:44 p.m.**
- **If you go to the old Train Station up West Mountain to Railroad Place, you may wait for a train and it will stop. The first two passengers from Corinth got on there this past weekend.**
- **Public needs to be more aware of the Daily Trains going up and Down the Track, expect trains and / or rail maintenance vehicles to be on the tracks at any or all times. Always be prepared for the down gates and please remember that trespassing on the Railroad right of way is unsafe and Illegal.**
- **Next summer will bring the arrival of a short line run like we had a year ago, called the Corinth Cannonball express, from Corinth to Thurman, three trains a day, so you may hop on/hop off at several places to spend some time.**
- **As you travel and hear the sound of the train whistle, enjoy, but proceed with caution.**
