To the Corinth Citizens,

An update on the aftermath of Irene.

I have had many telephone conferences with National Grid and The County of Saratoga Emergency Services.

We are actually very fortunate compared to our neighbors to the North and South of us. Example is that the Town of day has lost Power to all but 2 residents, and trees and wires are down all over, Most of Edinburg has no power.

Waterford, Halfmoon and Troy areas are still fighting flooding. Thank God we were spared most of these things.

There are at this time still 559 people without power in the South Corinth, Porter Corner, Angel Road, Comstock Road , 1 on Randall's Corners, and about 57 up County Route 10.

At this time there is no time of reconnection, because of the number of lines and feeders down in wooded areas. They will be doing areas with the largest number of outages first, for instance Clifton Park has 6,690 people out, I believe Galway has second most and Edinburg third, and so on goes the list. At this time there is not any reconnect times, but as the Power crews work 24/7 and we continue with the conference calls, I will keep you posted.

If folks need emergency care right away call 911, if you need essential things you can call Town Hall 654-9232, Emergency management, 361-0943, Supervisor 654- 9598, or the Sheriff Office non emergency number, 885-6761.

The highway crews have been out around the clock, along with the Fire Department, Jessup's Landing EMS, and National Grid. The Emergency Management chairs, Mayor and Myself have been in constant communications, keeping a handle on things. A sincere Thank You to all involved in this situation.
