

NOTICE OF TEMPORARY WATER SHUT DOWN

This notice is to inform you of a planned temporary water service outage and low pressure condition which may affect water customers in Town of Corinth Water District No. 5.

WHAT IS BEING DONE? - At approximately 9:00 AM, on the dates listed below, the Village water main supply to Town Water District No. 5 will be shut down to allow installation of valves and water main piping necessary for master meter vault installation. The shut down will last no longer than approximately five (5) hours. During the course of this work, every effort will be made to minimize the duration of impact. Service is expected to resume no later than 2:00 PM the same day.

BOIL WATER NOTICE: Because pressure loss is expected, a boil water order will be in effect for impacted water customers once service is fully restored. Bring tap water to a rolling boil, boil for one minute, and cool before using, or use bottled water certified for sale by the New York State Department of Health. It is likely that the boil water event will last 24-48 hours which will allow laboratory results to confirm that your water is again safe to drink. Boiled or bottled water should be used for drinking, making ice, washing dishes, brushing teeth, and preparing food until further notice.
