For New Homeowners: Basic and Enhanced STAR Exemption: Register online at <u>www.tax.ny.gov</u>. or contact NYS directly at 518-457-2036 weekdays, 8:30am -4:30pm for the STAR Credit.

If you had the Basic STAR exemption before 2016 and will turn 65 before December 31, 2026 you can **apply for the Enhanced STAR exemption** with the Assessment Office. The income limit is less than or equal to **\$107,300**.

6. Homeowner Benefit Portal:

In May 2024, New York State launched the **Homeowner Benefit Portal**, a new resource to assist homeowners with property tax credits and exemptions. To access the portal, visit the Real Property Tax section of the official website at www.tax.ny.gov/pit/property/homeowner-benefit-portal. If you

already have a Tax Department Individual Online Service account, you can log in directly. For those without an account, simply create one to get started.

This easy-to-use online platform allows you to manage important aspects of your STAR (School Tax Relief) credit and more. Key features of the portal include:

- **Register for the STAR Credit**: Easily apply for the STAR credit, which offers property tax savings to eligible homeowners.
- **Enroll in Direct Deposit:** Set up direct deposit for your STAR Credit check, speeding up the delivery of your savings. Please note that direct deposit enrollment is not available over the phone.
- **Check Property Tax Registration Status:** View and manage the status of your property tax registration.
- Switch from STAR Exemption to STAR Credit: If you are currently receiving the STAR exemption, you can switch to the STAR credit for more flexible benefits.
- **Provide Household Income Information:** Ensure your eligibility is properly determined by submitting necessary income details.

7. Protect Yourself from Deed Theft:

Deed theft, also known as property fraud, occurs when someone illegally transfers your property into their name. To safeguard against this, the Saratoga County Clerk's Office offers a free Property Fraud Alert service. By signing up, you'll receive email notifications whenever a document is recorded under your name, allowing you to act promptly if something appears suspicious.
