Important information about STAR Tax Program: Beginning in 2026

⇒Seniors no longer need to apply to their assessor to qualify for the ENHANCED STAR Exemption.

 \rightleftharpoons Only 1 resident owner of the property (regardless of the relationship of the owners) must be 65 as of 12/31 of the benefit year.

NYS will send a letter to BASIC STAR recipients who may be eligible for the ENHANCED STAR Exemption.

Exemption recipients will not need to apply online but can check if their information is accurate on the Homeowner Benefit Portal: https://www.tax.ny.gov/pit/property/homeowner-benefit-portal.htm

New homeowners must apply for the STAR Credit Check or Direct Deposit & are not eligible for the exemption.
