From the Town's Building & Code Enforcement Officer: Building permits are required for:

Residential minor remodeling-any single work item that could affect the integrity or appearance of the structure such as a bay/bow window or sliding glass doors.*Must meet energy codes. **Residential major remodeling**-repairs at one address that includes 3 or more structural or system repairs and/or replacements, such as foundations, roof, electrical, plumbing, heating, well, septic, etc., which will require numerous on-site visits at various phases of project completions.
