**RESOLUTION SCHEDULING PUBLIC HEARING
ON PROPOSED LOCAL LAW NO. 3 OF 2022
AMENDING THE TOWN OF CORINTH TOWN CODE TO ESTABLISH REGULATIONS FOR
SOLAR ENERGY SYSTEMS**

WHEREAS, the Town Board is considering adoption of proposed Local Law No.: 3 of 2022 entitled, "A Local Law Amending the Town of Corinth Town Code to Establish Regulations for Solar Energy Systems"; and

WHEREAS, adoption of this Local Law is authorized by New York Municipal Home Rule Law §10; and

WHEREAS, Municipal Home Rule Law §20 requires the Town Board to hold a Public Hearing prior to the adoption of any Local Law; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED, that the Corinth Town Board shall meet and hold a public hearing beginning at the Corinth Town Hall, 600 Palmer Avenue, Corinth, New York, beginning at 06:05 p.m. on Thursday May 26, 2022 to hear all interested persons and take any necessary action provided by law concerning proposed Local Law No.: 3 of 2022, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Town Board further authorizes and directs the Town Clerk to provide notice and/or referrals regarding the proposed Local Law as required by State and Local Laws, including notice and referral to the Town of Corinth Planning Board, the Saratoga County Planning Board and any municipalities within 500 feet of properties that would be impacted by the proposed Local Law; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Town Board further authorizes and directs the Corinth Town Clerk to publish and post a Notice of Public Hearing concerning proposed Local Law No. 3 of 2022 in the manner provided by law and to make a copy of the proposed Local Law available for public inspection in the Town Clerk's office following the adoption of this Resolution and until the Public Hearing is closed.
