#### **RESOLUTION DECLARING THE CDBG MOBILE AND MANUFACTURED HOME PROGRAM USING 2023 NYS COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) FUNDING TO CONSIST OF TYPE II ACTIONS UNDER THE STATE ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY REVIEW ACT (SEQRA)**

**WHEREAS**, federal grant funding is available through the NYS Homes and Community Renewal to support local housing and community development activities which are undertaken by eligible municipalities; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Corinth is applying for such funding through the 2023 Program Year funding competition under the NYS Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Corinth will use the 2023 CDBG funds to implement a community-wide mobile and manufactured home replacement program for existing eligible owner-occupied homes located within the Town of Corinth; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town has designated Supervisor Eric Butler as the Certifying Officer for the Town; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town is required by federal regulations to undertake an environmental review of 2023 CDBG Program activities, included under NEPA and SEQRA, prior the funds being awarded by the NYS Office of Community Renewal; now therefore

**BE IT RESOLVED**, the Town of Corinth has completed the attached SEQR short environmental assessment form (EAF) for the CDBG Housing Rehabilitation 2023 Program, and therefore

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, the Town Board has declared the CDBG mobile and manufactured home replacement 2023 Program to consist of Type II Actions under SEQRA in accordance with 6 NYCRR §617.5(c)(1), (2), and (11).
